Progress is a daughter of Whitbread Golding, developed at Wye College and released for commercial breeding in 1964. Progress is somewhat similar to Fuggle but slightly sweeter and usually providing a softer bitterness in beers of all types. Progress shows an aroma profile and dual-purpose alpha level, ideally suited to British Ales.
