Toyomidori is a Japanese variety, bred by Kirin and released 1981. It is meant to be a bittering hop with an alpha content of 11.0 to 13.0 % and a comparably poor yield of about 1 mt/ha. This variety is a cross between Northern Brewer and a Wye male and is the parent of Azacca.
