Southern Promise is a diploid seedling from a cross between Southern Brewer and a wild male Yugoslavian variety. Since 1992, Southern Promise has replaced the variety Southern Brewer and, along with Southern Star, has had a major influence on hop growing in South Africa: both varieties grow even with minimal daylight – something which was a limiting factor in this growing region in the past.
