Southern Star, a cross between Outeniqua and a South African male variety, was released onto the market in 2001. Both Southern Star and Southern Promise have had a marked effect on hop growing in South Africa: both varieties grow even with minimal daylight – something which was a limiting factor in this growing region in the past.
